Code of Conduct – Guidelines for Breaches

It is expected that all members and spectators of Magpies Netball Club follow the Terms and Conditions as recorded on the club website. This includes references to the Codes of Conduct of Netball Queensland, Netball Australia, Mackay Netball Association and Magpies Sporting Club. In cases where this doesn't occur, the following guidelines can be used to manage the behaviour on a club basis.

All breaches (regardless of level) must be recorded in coach diary and initialled by coach and manager.

Level	Description of Behaviour	Action and Penalty
React	Negative comments, tone or body language towards players or officials e.g. rolls of eyes, frustration or sighs as a reaction	 Speak to member about controlling their comments and reactions. Encourage positivity and discourage complaints about umpire calls.
Minor	Repeated negative comments, tone or body language towards players or officials Behaviour against the spirit of the game towards players or officials of any club e.g. not standing out of play, deliberate contact, backchat to officials	 Speak to member at next break. If no improvement, member is benched for remainder of the game. Repetition of behaviours is not just within the one game. Behaviours are tracked across games and trainings and progress up the levels if behaviours continue.
Major	Ongoing negative comments, tone or body language towards players or officials Ongoing behaviour against the spirit of the game towards players or officials of any club Umpire suspension of a player or spectator from any game	 Bench player for remainder of the game. Written apology to team and club. 1-3 weeks suspension from club fixtures. Inability to be recognised for end of year awards. May be unable to attend end of year awards Any further breaches may result in termination of club membership and inability to register in future years with Magpies Netball Club. Coach/s and manager opinion on appropriateness of suspension is considered.
	Physically harming or attacking	 If considered appropriate, bench player for remainder of the game. Other major penalties as outlined above.
	another player, umpire, official or spectator. Unruly behaviour by a club official or spectator associated with the club	 Bench player for remainder of the game. Written apology to team and club. 3-6 weeks suspension from club fixtures or longer at the discretion of the executive. Inability to be recognised for or attend end of year awards. May result in termination of club membership. Any further breaches may result in termination of club membership and inability to register in future years with Magpies Netball Club.
	Failure to adjust behaviour after umpire official warning/suspension Bringing club/sponsor's name into disrepute	
	Making disparaging public comments via social media	

Immediate game-based actions will be managed by the coach/s and manager based on the game situation. Please refer any other situation to a member of executive straight after the game. The committee will consider all reports and take action following the club's Dispute Resolution Process.
