



Being a great TEAM MANAGER



EXEMPLIFY CLUB VALUES

Be a positive example of how to behave at netball. Follow our club values and code of conduct at all times. Keep all information related to your team members private.

PLAYER BEHAVIOUR

Assist the coach to manage the behaviour of all team members. Discuss any negative behaviour with the coach and record it in Coach Book. Bring any issues to the attention of the committee.

SCORING

Ensure every game is being scored. You are not expected to score each game. Encourage others to help too. Teach them how to do so.

TEAM COMMUNICATION

Be the primary source of information to your team. Ensure all requests from the committee are communicated to the team via your chosen format e.g. Messenger. Encourage full attendance at trainings. Ensure game absences are communicated to coach so subs can be arranged.

SCORING – PAPER

Collect score card, ensure players are ticked off and any subs written on the card. Have coach sign score card to confirm players. Score in conjunction with opposition scorer. In finals, sit in allocated scoring position.

COMMUNICATE WITH THE CLUB

Provide any information to the club as needed. If there are any issues that arise in the season, promptly discuss these with a member of the committee.

SCORING – ELECTRONIC

Before the game starts, log into Netball Connect through the app. Assign a scorer to the game (it does not need to be you). Follow MNA guidelines to score game.

COLLECT ALL MONEY

Collect any money for fundraising efforts or photos keeping accurate records of who has paid. Chase up any outstanding payments. In Seniors, collect umpiring money from players and hand to umpiring coordinator.

SUPPORT THE COACH

Reinforce and reiterate the team objectives and goals as set by the coach and team. Encourage on time attendance to all trainings. Remain positive.
