BEHAVIOUR

At Magpies Netball Club, we have very high behaviour expectations. These are outlined in the Codes of Conduct Netball Australia, Netball Oueensland. Mackay Netball Association and Magpies Sporting ΑII players, officials spectators are obliged to abide by these codes. If you keep our values in mind, you will be on the right track. INJURY CLEARANCE

If a player has an injury that keeps them off the court for more than 2 weeks, a medical clearance will be needed prior to being allowed to play again. We have seen too many members reinjured of late because they return too soon so this is to protect our members in the long run.

RAFFLES

Your team will be rostered to complete the raffles at Magpies Sporting Club throughout the year. It usually takes about 30 minutes on a Tuesday night and is lots of fun. It is an easy way to give back to the club. Please say yes when you are asked!

COMMUNICATION

Please respond quickly to any communication within your team so that coaches or managers know your thoughts.







TRAINING - READ CAREFULLY

Primarily occurs at the Mackay Netball Association courts in Casey Avenue. All training times are left up to the coaches and will usually stay the same throughout the season. Parents and players are responsible for arrival and pick-up from training. It is the players' responsibility to train with their team regularly. Please contact your coach or manager if you are unable to train or play. Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. How you train is how you play! If you miss training without notifying your coach, your court time will be affected.

UNIFORMS

There are two choices for our uniform. One is a black and white dress and the other is a shirt and shorts combination. Both of these are purchased from the club. These uniforms must be worn for all club games. Bummers/netball shorts: Black netball shorts or bummers should be worn under the dress. These pants must not be visible below the hemline of the dress when the player is in a standing position. Shoes: There are no restrictions as to the type of runners needed for netball however, we recommend that they are in good condition in order to provide good support for ankles and feet. Training singlets and socks will be provided during the season for those who are new to the club or who need replacements.

UMPIRING

NEVER CRITICISE AN UMPIRE. If it is believed that an umpire needs support, team coaches or managers will find a member of our committee who will assist with finding appropriate support.

Umpiring in 2025 is changing with the MNA Umpiring Committee looking after development and allocation of umpires for all competitive grades. We will continue our mentoring program for our beginner umpires and our mentors will also be a big part of the MNA umpiring group. Team White is super important and we will continue to support the development of umpires.

All umpires will need to be registered through Mackay Netball. All game allocations (except for NetSetGo) will be done through the Netball Connect app. Please ensure your notifications are turned on and you respond to your allocations urgently each week.
