Code of Conduct - Coaches



- 1. Operate within the rules and spirit of netball, promoting fair play over winning at any cost and teach your players to do the same.
- 2. Treat all players with respect always, by being honest and consistent with them.
- 3. Be reasonable in your demands on players' time, energy and enthusiasm.
- 4. Promote a climate of mutual support among your players.
- 5. Encourage players to respect one another and to expect respect for their worth as individuals regardless of their level of play.
- 6. Respect the rights and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 7. Involve the players in decisions that affect them.
- 8. Determine, in consultation with players, what information is confidential and respect that confidentiality.
- 9. Help each person (athlete, umpire etc) reach their potential
- 10. Respect the talent, developmental stage and goals of each person
- 11. Compliment and encourage with positive and supportive feedback
- 12. Avoid overly negative feedback
- 13. Display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with the sport. This includes opponents, coaches, umpires, officials, administrators, the media, parents and spectators. Encourage players to do the same.
- 14. Where practical, avoid unaccompanied and unobserved one-on-one activity (when in a supervisory capacity or where power imbalance exists) with people less than the age of 18 years.
- 15. Any physical contact with a young player should be appropriate to the situation and necessary for the player's skill development.
- 16. Place the safety and welfare of the athletes above all else.

17.	Obtain appropriate qualifications and keep up-to-date with the latest
	coaching practices and the principles of growth and development of young
	people.

- 18. Never post or send inappropriate comments via the Internet or ICT about any netball official, affiliated association, affiliated club, umpire, coach, registered member and/or organising body.
- 19. At all times use appropriate training methods, which will benefit the players and avoid those which could be harmful.
- 20. Ensure that the tasks, trainings, equipment and facilities are safe and suitable for age, experience, ability and physical and psychological conditions of the players.
